The 2013 Landmark Conference coach of the year, Howes has amassed more victories (175) in his first nine years than any other coach in CUA basketball history. He has guided the Cardinals to multiple Landmark and Capital Athletic Conference championships and NCAA Division III Tournaments. Additionally, he has coached a first team All-Conference performer in eight of his nine years as head coach.

A former player and assistant under coach Mike Lonergan, Howes assisted with the recruitment of the 2001 national championship team. He has conducted workouts for a myriad of college and professional players. Among the athletes he helped develop is New Orleans Hornets' guard Roger Mason.



CUA Women's Coach
Matt Donohue
Centenary College '94

In his thirteen years as a head coach, Donohue has guided multiple regionally and nationally ranked programs to post season play. A two-time Coach of the Year Award recipient, he has guided multiple All-Conference, All Region, and All-American athletes, as well as, Conference Player and Rookie of the Year recipients. This past season (2013) Donohue led CUA to its second consecutive Landmark Conference Championship, as well as, a return trip to the NCAA Championship Tournament.

The 2013 WBCA Russell Athletic Victory Club Award Recipient, Donohue, earned the 200th win of his coaching career this past season. Along the way he became the all-time winningest women's basketball coach in school history.
